Rising from the floor like an art sculpture, the Artist Side Table is all about balancing geometric shapes to create a significant and vocal point in the room.

Crafted from FSC-certified American Red Oak, the console celebrates the quiet strength of a living material. The natural grain brings subtle character to the surface, while the hardwood's durability ensures stability for everyday use and a patina that deepens beautifully over time.

Finished in Coffee Black Oak, a profound dark brown that borders on black, the surface recalls oak aged to its deepest intensity. Beneath its shadowed tone lies a subtle warmth that adds depth and quiet sophistication to the sculptural form.

Perfect as a sculptural statement beside a sofa, next to a lounge chair, or framing a bed as a distinctive nightstand, it brings both function and artistry to any setting. The Artist Side Table is the perfect complement to our Toe Chair series.

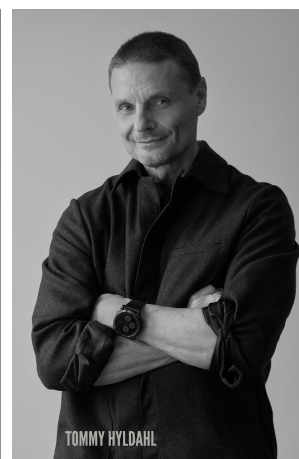
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



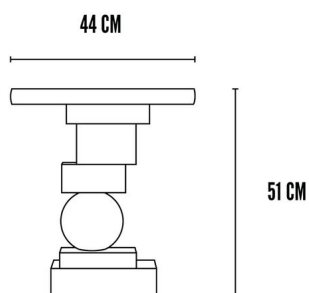

Family Description Text

The Toe Series is more than a collection of lounge furniture. It is an ode to the bold optimism of the 1970s space age, reimagined for contemporary living. Here furniture becomes sculpture and comfort becomes a form of architecture. Thick, fluted upholstery flows across seamless forms like a soft rhythm, shaping generous volumes that feel both expressive and serene.

Defined by rounded geometries and sculptural proportions, the series shares a unified language of tactile softness and effortless comfort. Seats and backrests are shaped from layers of premium foam, creating flowing contours that gently embrace the body while maintaining a strong architectural presence.

Most pieces express the purity of the upholstered form, including the Toe Ottoman, Toe Lounge, Toe Armchair and Toe Flat. The Toe Armrest Chair and Toe Sofa Armrest introduce a contrasting architectural element through solid oak armrests for indoor settings or teak for outdoor environments. Formed from thick planks and shaped like subtle wings, they provide natural support for the hand while also serving as a practical resting surface for everyday essentials.

Together the Toe Series transforms interiors into spaces of imagination where the spirit of futurism meets contemporary craftsmanship. More than seating, it is comfort shaped into sculpture and design distilled into poetry.

Color Description

Coffee Black Oak is a profound, very dark brown that borders on black, recalling the richness of oak aged to its deepest intensity. With warmth hidden beneath its shadowed surface, it carries both strength and subtlety. This near-black shade speaks of quiet sophistication, timeless depth, and a natural elegance that grounds and enriches any setting.

Maintenance Guide Description

American Red Oak is a durable hardwood that matures beautifully, developing a rich patina over time. To maintain its character, dust surfaces regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For deeper cleaning, wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth in the direction of the grain, then dry immediately to prevent moisture from settling.

Avoid abrasive cleaners, silicone-based polishes, or excess water, as these can damage the surface or raise the grain. Protect oak with coasters, mats, or felt pads to prevent stains, scratches, and heat marks. Wipe spills promptly, and keep furniture away from direct sunlight, high humidity, or heat sources to prevent fading, cracking, or warping.

With mindful care, American Red Oak will preserve its natural strength and warmth, aging with quiet elegance and becoming richer in character over the years.

FSC-certified and responsibly sourced, this hardwood carries the quiet strength of the forests it comes from. Oak's tight grain and inherent strength make it ideal for everyday use, while its warm tones and textured surface add a grounded, refined beauty.
