The Smoked Desert colour adds a soft, warm grey with delicate translucency, reminiscent of early morning mist.

Great as a stand alone table or combine the tall Trumpet table with the the Low Trumpet table for a harmonious composition.

Each Trumpet Table is meticulously crafted through a traditional mouth-blown glass technique. The beautifully handcrafted table is mounted on a wooden base with internal metal support, ensuring both durability and balance.

Due to the artisanal nature of the production process, small air bubbles or subtle variations may naturally occur, making each piece truly unique. With its sculptural presence and exceptional craftsmanship, the Trumpet Table is a testament to modern simplicity an elegant yet playful addition to both residential and commercial interiors.

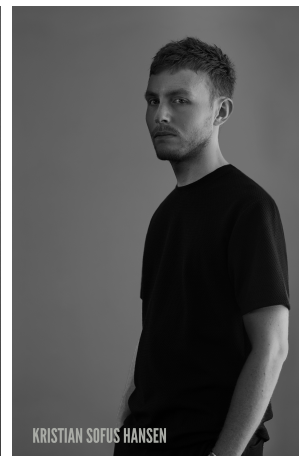
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



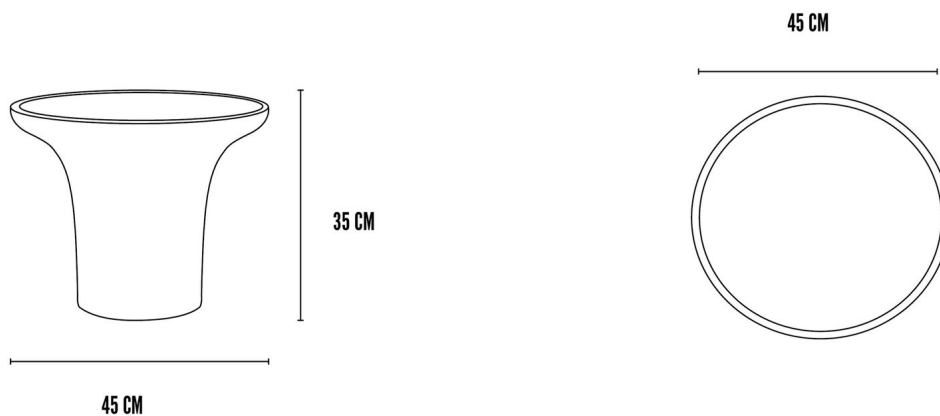

Family Description Text

The Trumpet Collection, born from the bold spirit of the 1970s, is a celebration of sculptural form and refined simplicity. With its graceful curves and trumpet shaped silhouette, the collection resonates like a note held in suspension, a gesture of music translated into form. Meticulously crafted through traditional techniques, the Trumpet Collection reveals itself in two expressions, each with its own soul. One is formed entirely from glass, a luminous sculpture that captures light as though it were sound, refracting it into warmth and depth, while the other is grounded, tactile, and architectural, with a sculptural base in hand painted fibre concrete crowned by a disc of natural stones. Together, these interpretations embody the essence of the Trumpet Collection: modern yet timeless, bold yet refined, simple yet expressive, a presence that draws the eye and shifts the energy of a room.

Maintenance Guide Description

Though delicate in appearance, the glass is strong and durable, designed for everyday use in decorative and functional objects. To maintain its pristine look, we recommend regular cleaning with a soft microfiber cloth and a gentle glass cleaner or diluted soap solution. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth (not directly on the glass) and wipe in smooth, circular motions. Always dry with a clean cloth to prevent streaks or water marks. Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or acidic substances, which can dull or damage the glossy surface. For tables, use coasters or felt pads under objects to prevent scratches or thermal shock from hot items. While the glass is moisture-resistant, it's best to avoid prolonged exposure to standing water or humidity, especially for vases empty and dry them between uses to preserve the finish. Elegant, minimal, and low-maintenance, our glass combines lasting beauty with functional design. With a little care, your table or vase will retain its distinctive charm for years to come.

Materials Description

Our painted glass is created by applying pigment to the inner surface of the glass, a process that preserves the smooth clarity of the outer layer while enriching the material with depth and character. Though visually and tactilely identical to colored glass, the painted finish adds an artisanal dimension, with subtle variations that make each piece unique.

Durable yet refined, painted glass reflects light with the same purity and brilliance as coloured glass, offering a timeless surface that balances precision, craftsmanship, and contemporary expression.
